Garage Floor & Driveway Cleaner

DESCRIPTION

Powerful grease-stripping action removes oil, grease and dirt from driveways, garage floors, patios and sidewalks.

RECOMMENDED USES

Designed to clean and remove oil, grease and dirt safely from concrete and asphalt driveways, garage floors, patios, sidewalks and carports.

APPLICATION

Use at full strength. Apply to surface and work in with a stiff brush or broom. Let soak for five minutes, but do not allow to dry. Scrub surface again then thoroughly rinse with water. For heavily built-up stains more than one application may be necessary. One gallon will clean 250 to 300 sq. ft. Wash hands thoroughly after use.

ENVIRONMENTAL VARIABLES

If some stains remain use household bleach to remove. Do not use on unsealed wood, aluminum, glass or marble. One gallon will clean 250 to 300 sq. ft.

CLEAN-UP

Wash hands with warm water and soap.

CAUTIONS

Use goggles, rubber gloves and old clothing to avoid irritation. Do not allow contact with eyes and skin. Keep children and pets away from working area.

Avoid extreme temperatures. Store in a cool, dry area. Close container after each use. Do not mix with other household chemicals –generation of hazardous gases may occur. If frozen, thaw and mix before use.

Use up or give away excess product. Do not reuse empty container. Rinse and place in trash or recycling receptacle. To recycle or properly dispose of paint in your community, call 1-800-CLEANUP (USA only).
